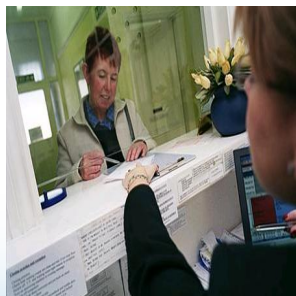

- If needed, your child can be referred back here in the future
